Please note that the law requires you to notify the Council's Monitoring Officer, within 28 days of becoming a member of any disclosable pecuniary interest which you have at the date of this notification. You are required to update this notification if you are re-elected or re-appointed and in the circumstances set out in section 31(7) of the Localism Act 2011. It is a criminal offence if, without reasonable excuse, you fail to do this, or if the notification you give contains false or misleading information and you know this or are reckless as to whether the information is true and not misleading.

Where you consider in respect of one of your interests that the nature of that interest is such that disclosure of its details could lead to you, or a person connected with you, being subject to violence or intimidation, you should discuss this with the Monitoring Officer. If s/he agrees that that interest is a Sensitive Interest, the published version of the register will not include details of that interest (and may instead state that you have a Sensitive Interest).

Where the interest is no longer a 'Sensitive Interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change.
